Kenneth R. Cole, Pastor Emeritus

On Sunday, June 20, 2010, First Baptist Church of Walton bestowed upon Kenneth R. Cole the title of Pastor Emeritus. Rev. Cole served there as pastor August, 1979—August, 1993.

The term "Pastor Emeritus" is used by a local church to honor a person whose lengthy ministry in that local church has been one of distinguished service. The designation recognizes an individual's retirement from that particular local church and from active ordained ministry. Conferring this status is an act of a local church and is an honor that the church may wish to consider following the pastor's departure.

The work "Emeritus" has to do with being retired from active service while retaining one's title as an honor. The retaining of title is offered because of merit earned during the time of active service. The honor is never an automatic one but rather is a recognition of exceptional service.
