SBC Baptisms Fall to Lowest Mark in Years was a front-page headline in the June 14, 2011 issue of our state Baptist paper, Western Recorder.

That headline should worry us, right? No! It should light a fire under us.

There are several large, non-Baptist churches in Northern Kentucky that are growing. Therefore, they are showing us that churches can grow in 2011. (Sometimes we discount them by saying "They are using gimmicks," or "They aren't preaching the Gospel." I don't say that.)

To see our churches grow through baptisms we have to:

- 1. Understand the people of our communities. (who are they, what gets their attention, and do we want to reach them?)
2. Focus on relationship evangelism. ( I don't get preachy on Facebook but try to build relationships.) Relationships build trust, and trust allows us to share our faith effectively.

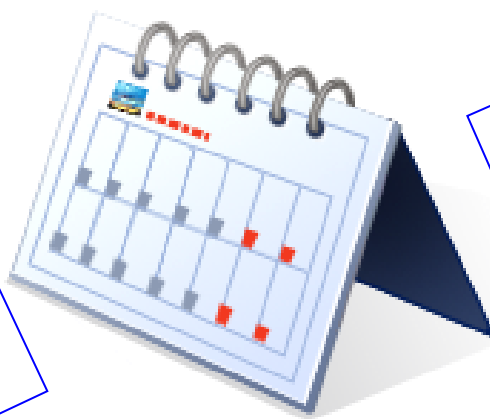
