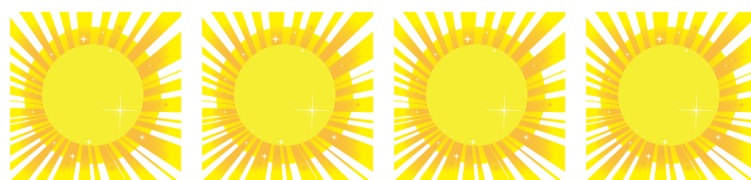

Disaster Relief Responding to Tornadoes, Flooding

KBC Disaster Relief Update

Alabama Tornadoes

Nine Kentucky Baptist chainsaw teams and two mobile shower units are currently headquartered in Dutton, Ala., assisting with disaster recovery following devastating tornadoes on April 27.

The teams, comprised of between 60-70 volunteers, are coming from Baptist disaster relief units from Stanford, Somerset, Richmond, California, Bowling Green, Cadiz, Williamstown, Benton, and Monticello.

They are operating from Happy Home Baptist Church in nearby Henegar, Ala., under the direction of veteran disaster relief coordinator Larry Koch of Taylorsville.

Kentucky is just one of several state Baptist conventions responding to meet needs following the storms that left more than 300 dead. The disaster teams are being coordinated by the North American Mission Board of the Southern Baptist Convention.

Alabama Baptists are accepting donations of some items. If you wish to donate items, please take the following steps:

- **Before you collect items, Alabama has asked that each interested party call a church on the list to see what they need, what they already have enough of, etc.** There is a short list of items needed at the top of the list, but that may change each day.

Please **do not collect clothing**. No clothing donations are needed.

Kentucky Flooding

We have mobilized a shower unit to Salem in Livingston County for those being evacuated from communities along the Ohio River.

Kentucky Baptist Disaster Relief has completed work in West Point, Kentucky. A shower unit, a recovery unit, mud-out teams and chaplains are all part of the response.

We continue to monitor other areas of Kentucky for potential response.
